Dear Mr. Kevin Howell:

Thank you for participation in the open discussions of the adverse effects of the current transportation schedule on instructional and recess time at the school. As stated in the May 14, 2018 meeting minutes and raised again at the September 10, 2018 meeting, we have concerns as to the practicality of the 10-minute morning recess introduced this year as necessitated by the restrictions placed on the school bell times due to transportation alignment and required instructional time. While we appreciate that the morning and afternoon dismissal bell times have not changed for this year (early dismissal each Friday excepted), parents at the school have expressed to us their disappointment that the morning recess has been reduced from 15 minutes to 10 minutes. We respectfully request the return to a 15-minute recess be considered and integrated into the transportation and instructional planning by the start of the 2019/2020 school year. In support of our request, we have found the following Area 2 schools; each having similar bell times or instructional hours during the day yet all have a longer lunch, recess or both.
